March 7	<i>Who is Jesus?</i> What do his life and mission mean to us? How are we to be disciples in 21 st century America?
March 14	<i>How do we worship?</i> 'Decoding' the liturgy of the church.
March 21	<i>How are we nourished/sustained?</i> How does Christ continue to live with us through the sacraments?
March 28	<i>Who are we as a people?</i> What does it mean to be part of the church?
April 1 to April 8	Holy Week is a wonderful opportunity to live in "real time" the events of Jesus' passion and resurrection. Take this week to experience the saving truth of our faith, beginning with Palm Sunday. Carry through the rest of week by joining in the liturgies of the Triduum: Holy Thursday, April 5 - the Mass of the Lord's Supper - 7:30 PM Good Friday, April 6- the Commemoration of the Lord's Passion - 7:30 PM Easter Vigil, April 7 - the Celebration of the Resurrection of the Lord - 7:30 PM
April 11	Week off to celebrate Easter.
April 18	<i>How do we know?</i> The Scriptures and the Tradition of the church - how do we read them and what do they teach us?
April 25	<i>How do we live?</i> What does it mean to live the moral life of a disciple?
May 2	<i>How do we communicate?</i> Building a prayer life and keeping connection with the Lord.
Monday, May 7	Rehearsal at 7:00 PM. <i>Sponsors should also attend, if possible.</i>
Wednesday, May 9	Confessions in church - beginning at 6:30 PM, after the 6:00 PM mass
Friday, May 11	7:00 PM - Confirmation. Sponsors and candidates assemble at 6:30 PM. A reception will follow.
